Guidelines and requirements for this program:

1. Applicant must be a regular degree-seeking undergraduate student. Temporary, special, transient, conditional or non-degree seeking student do not meet this requirement.
 2. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student in an Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) accredited engineering, technology, or applied science program at a college or university in the State of Alabama.
 3. Applicant must provide two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a current or former member (within the last 5 years) of the Birmingham Chapter, Alabama Society of Professional Engineers.
 4. Applicants must submit a 500 word (maximum), type-written essay about their career plans and interest in pursuing an engineering education.
 5. Applicant must provide an official copy of undergraduate transcripts with the completed application.
 6. Student application must be received by May 4, 2009.
 7. The award value (to be determined) will be applied to of the cost tuition.
